

### **Guidelines for conducting online exam**

- Online examination will be conducted as per the circular provided by University of Mumbai.
- All theory examination will be conducted online with Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) as decided by University of Mumbai.
- All online theory exams will be conducted for a period of one hour for 50 marks (25 MCQs) which will be further converted to 80 marks.
- All theory exams will be based on the syllabus taught in the college till 13th March, 2020.
- As the Theory Examination is conducted in the form of Multiple-Choice Questions, Revaluation cannot be facilitated as per guideline of University of Mumbai.
- One helpdesk is established in college for the students to get counselling during the examination and to solve their possible problems and doubts.
