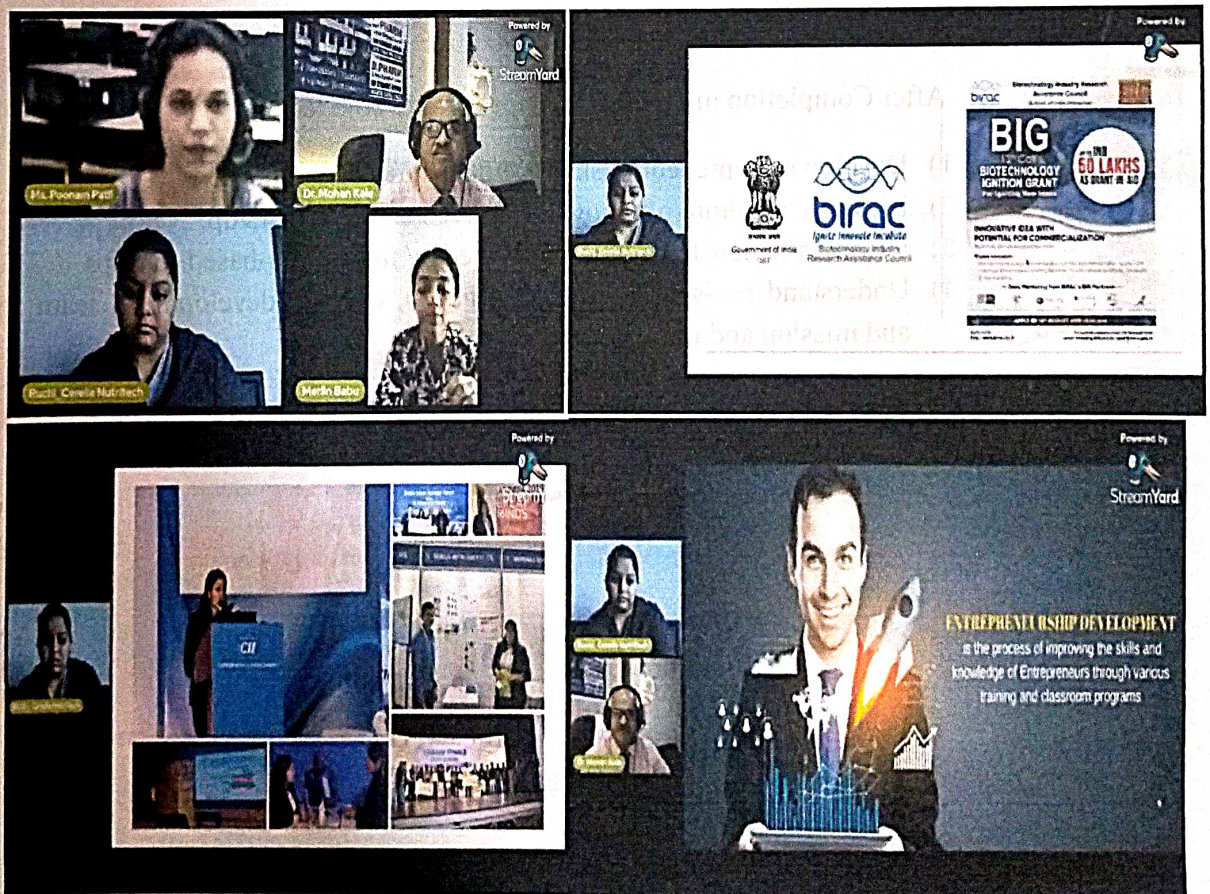
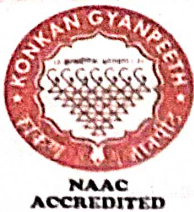


## A Report on "INNOVATION & STARTUP" 28<sup>th</sup> December 2021
